## EDUC 102 - Field Experience in Education

## Compliance Day attendance REQUIRED: Wed. August 27

Provides a structured field-based experience for students to observe teachers and students in local public schools. Applying concepts learned in **EDUC 101** or **PHED 201**, students reflect on the teaching and learning process. Experiences in small group and individual instruction provide a transition from theory to practice. Attendance at oncampus and school site orientations required before beginning observations. **PRE- or COREQUISITE(S): EDUC 101** or **PHED 201**. Five hours lecture and thirty hours practicum each semester.

Course Outcomes:

Upon completion of this course, a student will be able to:

- Observe, reflect on and interpret the educational philosophy, teaching style, and classroom management of the observed teacher(s).
- Examine and refine personal educational philosophy, teaching style and classroom management techniques for the future classroom.
- Identify the demands and rewards of teaching.
- Identify key factors affecting a positive school climate.
- Observe and record the variety of methods teachers employ to address the individual needs of students in the classroom.
- Recognize the value of classroom organization and lesson development.
- Observe and record typical characteristics of students in the observed age range.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the diverse needs of student populations in MCPS.
- Implement appropriate teaching techniques with small groups or individual students at the request of the mentor teacher.

CRN 20668 (RV), 22772 (TP), 22773 (GT): The Field Experience courses require 30 hours of observation time in a designated MCPS school. School placements are assigned in proximity to the campus where you enroll for the course. All students who enroll in a field experience course must go through a fingerprinting and clearance process.
