I am pleased to announce the appointment of Ms. Stephanie Landon as the acting dean of English language for academic purposes, linguistics, and communication studies. Ms. Landon assumed the duties and responsibilities of acting dean on August 30, 2025.

Ms. Landon joined Montgomery College in 2018 as full-time faculty in ELAP teaching all courses and levels in 15-week and accelerated formats in all modalities. In addition to her teaching experience, she has taken on leadership roles as ELAP Discipline Coordinator, ELAP Writing Coordinator, a Faculty Council member, a Cadre Advisor and interim Cadre Coordinator, Move-up Test Advising Team member, and a Rockville Faculty Senator. In addition, she has been a contributing fellow to the Smithsonian/EdX Course Collaboration, a Smithsonian Faculty Fellow, and a Global Humanities Fellow.

Previously, Ms. Landon served Frederick Community College as an ESL transition specialist and the ESL program manager, while also serving on the President's Diversity Advisory Council, Strategic Advisory Teams, Curriculum Committee and the Continuing Education and Workforce Development Program Manager's Team.

Ms. Landon earned a bachelor of arts in German language and literature from the University of California at Irvine, and a master of arts in teaching English to speakers of other languages from Simmons College in Massachusetts.
