The job description for the Collegewide Chair of the Honors College for Montgomery College has been posted, and I encourage all qualified and interested individuals at MC to apply for this leadership opportunity. This is the inaugural year of the Honors College, which brings together Montgomery Scholars, Renaissance Scholars, STEM Scholars, Early College Honors, and Macklin Business Institute under a single structure that retains their distinctive characteristics and yet reflects a cohesive collegewide vision, increasing program visibility, access, support and engagement opportunities, and student success outcomes.

Reporting to the Dean of the Honors College, the Honors Chair will serve as the academic lead to support Honors students' success. The Honors Chair will coordinate Honors curriculum development, faculty engagement, scheduling, and advising; lead assessment of learning outcomes, course evaluations, and experiential learning participation to drive continuous improvement; and collaborate with the Office of Communications and Honors leadership to ensure accurate and engaging website, catalog, and outreach materials. The Honors Chair will teach one 3 or 4-credit class per semester, as assigned.

The deadline to apply is January 9, 2026, by 11:59 p.m. Review of applications will begin on 10 January, with interviews and forums scheduled shortly thereafter for finalists, for a spring appointment.
